We would love to cast everyone who auditions, however, if we receive too many audition submissions, we may not be able to cast everyone. If we are unable to cast you, we will refund your production fee within 5-7 business days. We do NOT offer refunds after casting, for ANY reason unless we are unable to cast you in the show.

Additional information/requirements:

Auditions are open to anyone in grades 2nd through 9th. Please be prepared to sing a song that best suits your vocal range, for 1 minute. You need to provide your own music accompaniment by either phone, mp3 player or iPod. No accapella singing (without background music). Please bring your resume (if available) and a headshot or photo. Any photo will work, headshot, school picture, selfie, anything, but please bring one with you. You must select an audition time online here: <http://www.yatsandiego.org/tickets> or you can come to the theater and pick up a packet to complete.

We have a 15-minute ticket sales requirement. The tickets will be \$15.00 each with a cast code.

With every production we do some kind of fundraiser as well. These tickets are \$5 each and each cast member has a required 10 tickets to sell. The fundraiser for Junie B. Jones is an amazing Gift Card opportunity drawing.

We are a volunteer-based organization and we need help from everyone! Each cast member/parent is required to serve a minimum of 20 volunteer hours during the course of the production. We need assistance in the following committees: Costumes, Sets, Props, and Raffle, and we will need performance day volunteers in the areas of Concessions, Promotions, and Usher. Let us know if you would like to chair a committee. The chairperson is responsible for overseeing the committee members, developing a "To Do" list and making sure everything gets done. All committee chairs will receive a FREE Parent Pass. If you would like to be the committee chair, you will receive one free parent pass, \$25 value for your leadership. For those who are unable to help at all, you have the option of buying out of this commitment for the price of \$200. You must however be totally responsible for the functions of your committee.

Costumes:

Every cast member will have their costumes provided by YAT. However, there may be specific pieces that would be required for you to purchase, that you would also get to keep. Examples of these items are: shoes, under dressing, tights, socks, leotards, regular everyday clothes, etc.

Throw in a friendly cafeteria lady, a kickball tournament and a "Top-Secret Personal Beeswax Journal," and first grade has never been more exciting.

Featuring a tremendously loveable character and fun-filled songs, Junie B. Jones will capture your audience members' hearts just as the books captivated an entire generation of students. The small cast, minimal design needs and performance accompaniment tracks make this an ideal show for theatres looking to tour schools or with strong education programs.

Character Breakdown

Junie B. Jones

A quirky, energetic first grader with comedic flair. Loves having adventures and writing about them in her journal. Gets upset when things don't go her way. Wildly precocious, yet completely endearing.

Lucille

Junie B.'s former best friend, also in first grade. The ultimate child diva. Rich girl, well-dressed. In Mr. Scary's class with Junie B. Enthusiastic. Can be double cast as BOBBI JEAN PIPER and JOSE.

Herb

Junie B.'s new best friend. A cute boy, slightly shy. Endearing and charming. Can be double cast as CHENILLE.

May

Another first grader in Mr. Scary's class with Junie B. Bossy, know-it-all. Junie's nemesis. Can be double cast with MOMMY and GRACE.

Sheldon

Another first grader in Mr. Scary's class with Junie B. Nerdy, lactose intolerant, and gets a bit of stage fright. Excited about playing music. Can be double cast with CAMILLE and LENNIE.

Camille

Lucille's new best friend and Chenille's twin sister. A follower. Can be double cast with SHELDON and LENNIE.

Chenille

Lucille's other new best friend and Camille's twin sister. Coordinated and cute. Can be double cast with HERB.

Grace

Junie B.'s other former best friend. She rides the bus with Junie B. and is now best friends with Bobbi Jean Piper. Can be double cast with MOMMY and MAY.

Bobbi Jean Piper

Grace's new best friend. Can be double cast with LUCILLE and JOSE.

Jose

Another first grader in Mr. Scary's class. Speaks both Spanish and English. Can be double cast with LUCILLE and BOBBI JEAN PIPER.

Lennie

Another first grader. Can be double cast with SHELDON and CAMILLE.

Mr. Scary

Junie B.'s first grade teacher, a warm man, despite his name. Can be double cast with GLADYS GUTZMAN and DADDY.

Mother

Junie B.'s mom. Exasperated, but understanding. Can be double cast with GRACE and MAY.

Daddy

Junie B.'s dad. Encouraging and knows how to juggle. Can be double cast with MR. SCARY and MRS. GUTZMAN.

Featured dancers for The kids' favorite lunch lady at Junie B.'s elementary school, also known as "Gladys Gutzman, Queen of Snacks."
