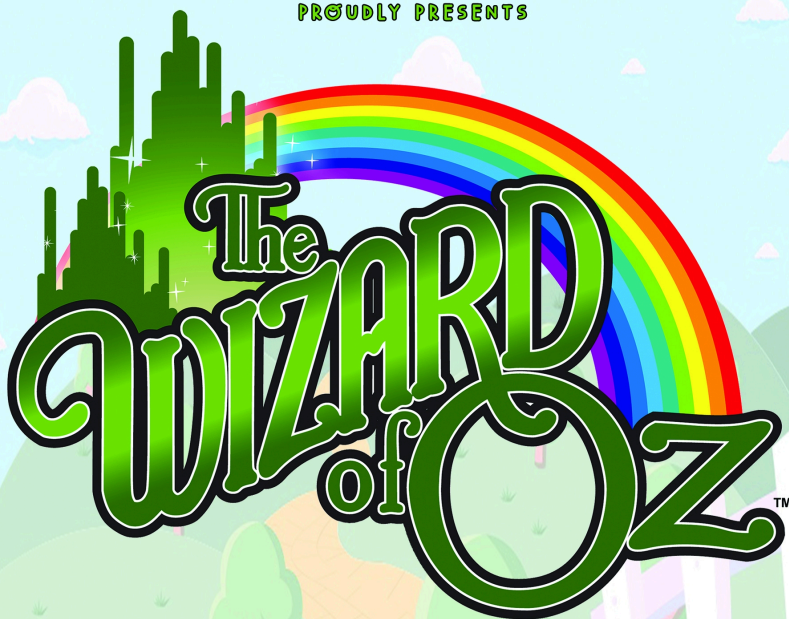

as Dorothy Gale

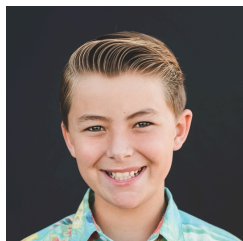

as Munchkin Mayor, Poppy, Winkie, Ozian

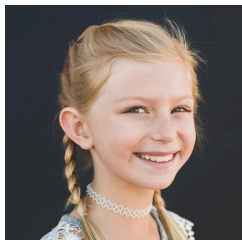

as Dance Captain, Tree, Poppy, Jitterbug, Tornado Dancer, Ozian

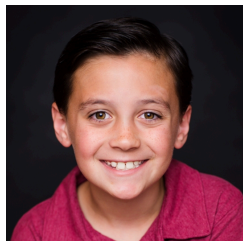

as Lollipop Guild, Monkey, Ozian

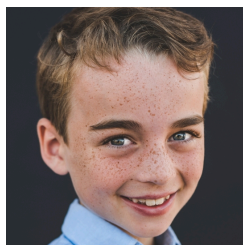

Director

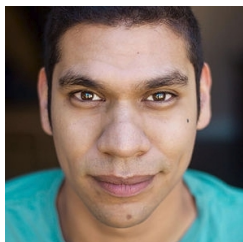

Music Director

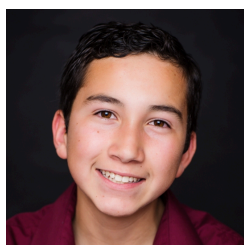
