For Participation in a YAT Production

Thank you for applying to the Young Actors' Theatre Scholarship fund. Our goal is to make certain that children from all walks of life enhance their education by including instruction in the performing arts. To that end Young Actors' Theatre gladly offers scholarships to families or children that may not otherwise be able to participate. As a registered 501 (c) (3) organization we feel it our obligation to serve the community of San Diego to the best of our ability.

Young Actors' Theatre does seek out supplemental income in order to provide these grants to our patrons. Many of our grantors request that we keep complete and accurate records on the performers to whom we provide assistance. However, this information is kept confidential. Some Grantors request some simple information, at which case we will let you know ahead of time, otherwise, It will not be shared with any other entity or marketing company. The grantors will receive a report that only lists demographics in total or aggregate form. The information is compiled into a group of statistics so your specific personal information will not be shared.

There are certain criteria set forth by the Board of Directors of Young Actors' Theatre to ensure that the scholarships may be fairly and correctly awarded without discrimination of any kind. Also, some Grantors have specific requests on how they would like to see their funds distributed. The basic program guidelines are as follows:

1. An application must be filled out completely and turned in prior to auditions.
2. Only one scholarship may be authorized per student.
3. Student is not eligible for a scholarship if any prior fees are outstanding.
4. Student must agree to complete the production in its entirety.
5. Only the production fee is waived. All other items, such as ticket sales requirements, class requirements, fundraisers, parent volunteer hours, ect., still have to be fulfilled.
5. Student must follow all behavior guidelines and rules. If behavioral problems persist, student can be dropped from the production.

If any of these guidelines are not followed, performer (or performer family) will not be cast in any future productions.
